1. Who is the controller of your personal data and how can you contact them?

2. What information do we collect about you and how do we obtain it?

We collect most of the data directly from you in connection with your use of our services.

This includes, in particular:

- **Data you provide to us:** This includes identification and contact data, such as your name, surname, telephone number, email address, postal address, date of birth, username, and password. It also includes payment data, such as bank details, and other data, such as records of communication between you and our company.
- **Automatically collected data:** This includes data about your device (such as IP address, device type, operating system), website usage data (such as the date, time, and duration of your visit, the country from which you access the website), and data about your use of services (such as login and logout information, account settings).
- **Data from third parties:** Some data is provided to us by third parties, such as trading platform providers that you choose to use our services or social networks if you decide to link them with your account on the website.

3. How do we use your personal data?

We use personal data for the following purposes:

- **Registration and User Account:** To use the services, you must register on the website and create an account. For this purpose, we process your personal data.
- **Provision of Services:** To provide you with our services, i.e., to give you the appropriate access, tools, and support, we need to process your personal data.
- **Marketing Communication:** If you are our current or past customer, we may occasionally send you marketing communications related to our services. Each email contains a link that allows you to easily unsubscribe from such communications.
- **Customer Support and Communication:** If you use our customer support services, we will process your personal data.
- **Improvement of Services:** We process your personal data to develop, test, and improve our services.
- **Analytics:** To obtain information about how our website and services are used, we analyze customer behavior.

4. How do we store and secure personal data?

We store your personal data in an encrypted database on computers and other devices.

To protect against unauthorized access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction of the data we collect and process, we have implemented organizational and technical measures that we strictly adhere to.

5. **To whom do we disclose your personal data?**

We disclose your data to persons who assist us in providing our services, including:

- **Trading platform providers**, to enable you to perform simulated trades.
- **Other third parties** that assist us in operating our website and providing our services (such as hosting and cloud service providers, payment processors, IT companies, and system administrators, marketing, and communication agencies).

Additionally, we may disclose your data to persons with whom you have consented to share your data and in cases where it is required by law.

6. **Do we transfer your data to third countries or international organizations?**

In some cases, your data may be transferred to third countries or international organizations. Such transfers occur only when adequate safeguards are in place to protect your personal data, and we will inform you accordingly.

7. **What are your rights and how can you exercise them?**

You can exercise all the rights mentioned below, including your right to erasure of personal data and the withdrawal of your consent, by sending a request to us via email at info@fx-funding.

There are no specific words you must use in your request, but please be specific enough so we can assist you (e.g., identify yourself, specify the right you wish to exercise, what action you wish us to take, details of what personal data you want erased/deleted, etc.).

- **Right of Access to Personal Data:** You can request confirmation as to whether your personal data is being processed. If we process your data, we will provide you with further information regarding the processing.

- **Right to Rectification of Personal Data:** If we process your personal data inaccurately, you can notify us, and we will rectify the inaccurate personal data without undue delay.

- **Right to Erasure of Personal Data (“Right to be Forgotten”):** You have the right to request the erasure of your personal data without undue delay, especially if the data is no longer necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

- **Right to Restriction of Processing:** In the cases mentioned in Article 18 of the GDPR, you have the right to request a restriction of processing of your personal data for a certain period.

- **Right to Data Portability:** In the case of automated processing based on your consent or to perform a contract, you have the right to receive your data in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format.

- **Right to Object:** If we process personal data based on our legitimate interest, you have the right to object to the processing.

- **Right to Withdraw Consent:** If processing is based on your consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time.

- **Right Not to Be Subject to Automated Decision-Making:** You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which significantly affects you.

- **Right to Lodge a Complaint with the Supervisory Authority:** If you believe we are processing your data in violation of applicable legal regulations, you can lodge a complaint with the relevant supervisory authority.
